History of DoD Impact Aid Funding September 2019

DoD Impact Aid Funding for military-connected students began in 1991. The funding was established to help school districts with significant concentrations of military-connected students that have faced the issues of lack of adequate funding for over a decade, base closures and realignments, deteriorating facilities, and safety since 9/11. School districts with 20% or more military students are eligible for this funding. DoD Impact Aid funding is seen as a quality of life program for military families and to help with the recruitment and retention in an all-volunteer service.
